- Copy of your dated sales receipt or invoice that identifies:

  - The make and model number of the installed equipment.
  - Installation date and address.
  - The total amount paid.

1. **APPLICATION:** This application and any required additional documentation must be filled out completely, truthfully, and accurately. These materials must be submitted within 30 days of the installation date and postmarked by September 30, 2014 to qualify for a rebate.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Equipment must be purchased new and installed by a plumbing and heating contractor licensed to perform work in DC at a residence within the District of Columbia between the dates of July 14, 2014 – September 30, 2014. Rebates for products installed after September 30, 2014 are subject to change. Equipment model numbers for boilers, furnaces, and water heaters must be listed on the DCSEU's Qualifying Product Lists to be eligible for a rebate. Equipment model numbers for central AC units must be listed on [www.ahridirectory.org](http://www.ahridirectory.org) to be eligible for rebates. 3. **REBATE LIMITS:** Rebates are limited to one per equipment type per household.
4. **INCENTIVE AMOUNTS:** Incentives offers are subject to change.
5. **INSTALLATION VERIFICATION:** Installations must be completed in accordance with all laws, codes and other requirements applicable under federal, state and local authority. The DCSEU reserves the right to review the installations in order to ensure compliance with all program requirements.
